

PENSACOLA HERITAGE FOUNDATION \$1,000 SCHOLARSHIP

APPLICANT INFORMATION SHEET

ELIGIBILITY: Any graduating high school student in Escambia or Santa Rosa Counties of the State of Florida, and who is planning to enter college in the Fall Semester of 2018.

AWARD: This is a one-time, non recurring scholarship made on a competitive basis. The recipient of this scholarship may attend any college or university of his/her choice, other than a full ride college/university such as a military academy at which most or nearly all of the expenses associated with attending school are borne by the college/university/government. The scholarship funds will be sent to the college/university for disbursement. If the applicant matriculates into the college/university and subsequently drops out of studies or changes/enrolls into a full ride college/university, the remaining unused funds will be returned to Pensacola Heritage Foundation.

WHAT APPLICANTS MUST DO: Applications will be available through the student's high school guidance counselors and posted on the Pensacola Heritage Foundation website at: **pensacolaheritage.org**. The application consists of:

1. Family Information Sheet
2. High School Certification
3. An essay not to exceed 1,000 words on the subject of **Pensacola's Local Heritage**.

The essay portion will be juried by a committee composed of Pensacola Heritage Foundation members who will read the essays without regard to the identity of the essay's author. The PHF education committee will then make the selection of the winning applicants based on the committee's input. Names of the applicant will not be on the essay which will encourage choosing the essay on content alone. Pensacola Heritage Foundation will have rights of publishing submitted essays in newspapers and magazines, and Pensacola Heritage Foundation will have the right to use the essays in future publication.

The application must be received by Pensacola Heritage Foundation by March 26, 2018, and the winning applicant will be notified on or about April 16, 2018, by the President of Pensacola Heritage Foundation, or her representative with a follow up news release in the local newspapers.
